





Ludhiana:

- Tie up with 'Margdarshan', an ITI targeting slum dwellers and school dropouts. Their soft skill training program is highly promising with guaranteed placements in factories, malls, hospitals etc. FLO is recruiting as well as sponsoring candidates for the same.
- A separate batch is being trained for knitting stitching and crotchet. FLO Ludhiana is putting their products up regularly in all the events for sales and orders
- Working with widow homes, wherein the women are trained under various corporates / FLO volunteer and are given employability through placement agencies and other corporate houses.
- Ladies of village Bangsipura are actively involved in paper bag making. A few have even begun to participate in exhibitions

- Swayam -An online and off line Business consultancy cell for women who have an idea and want to make it into a business.
- Prevention of Sexual Harassment on Women at Work Place An Online Training Module. The program has been successfully implemented in organisations such as- HPCL- 3000; Bisleri- 167 employees; DSP- 114 employees

Northeast:

- Skilling Initiatives in Kiling village continued with the visit of well qualified Weaving Expert and Designer, Mrs Annanya Sharma. Colourful yarns were distribute to the weavers and they will provide finished products before Rongali Bihu in April.
- The programmes are not just one-off events, but proceed from skilling to marketing of the products
- Upskilling & empowerment with holistic inclusion of economic, health & nutrition, sanitation, education, electricity, upgradation of skills with master weavers from Central Silk Board, etc.


